About ICMR-NIIH

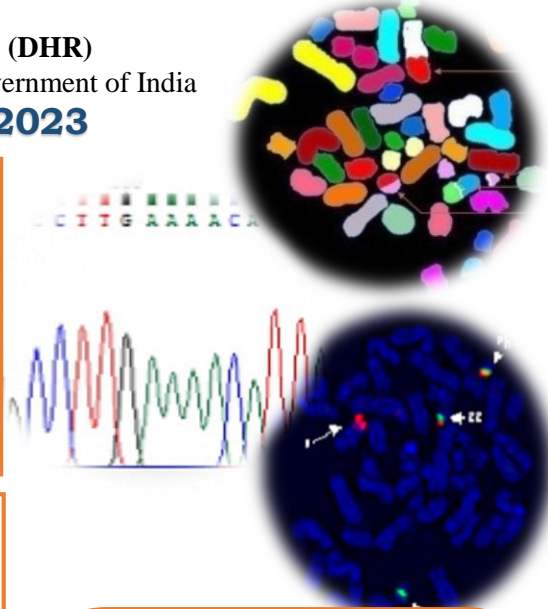

About the Course

The aim of the course is to impart the knowledge of Genetics and the technology used in Clinical practice and biomedical research. The 3-week course will cover lectures hands-on-training for Karyotyping, FISH, PCR, DNA sequencing, real time PCR, Next Generation Sequencing, and Bioinformatics with lab tutorials and interactive session on Human Genetics. The course also comprises a module on Research Methodology; Statistical analysis tools and grant writing for the project proposals.

- Faculty of Government Medical Colleges, Model Health research Units (MRHRUs), Multidisciplinary Research Units (MRUs) and research institutes/ Universities with MBBS/MD.
- Candidates from North-East and semi- urban/rural regions of India are encouraged to apply.
